HERITAGE SCHOOL BRICKS

Honor a special teacher, friend or family member, or celebrate graduations by purchasing an inscribed brick to be placed along the sidewalk leading to Heritage School.

The Cunningham School, Saunders County District 113, was originally located near Valparaiso, Nebraska. It was moved to Heritage Village in State Fair Park in 1975 and to the Nature Center in 2009.

Many area 4th grade students have the opportunity to experience history as they spend a school day as it might have been in the late 1800's.

A contribution of \$250 will buy an inscribed paver measuring 5.5" x 8" with two (2) lines of sixteen (16) characters per line.

All donors receive a commemorative certificate suitable for framing which can be presented to the honoree or honoree's family. Names of honorees will be listed in the Nature Center Newsletter and on our website.

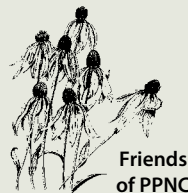


ABOUT THE NATURE CENTER

STEPPING STONES TO ELK BRIDGE

Here is a way to support Pioneers Park Nature Center in honor of a friend or loved one or to celebrate events such as birthdays, anniversaries, or holidays.

The path to the elk bridge is one of our most traveled trails. It winds between the Prairie Building and the bridge and platforms where you can watch our elk or white-tailed deer herds, or simply relax on a bench under stately murmuring cottonwoods. The path continues to Martin Prairie and its beautiful pond.

A contribution of \$500 will buy an inscribed stone measuring approximately 10" x 13" with two (2) lines of sixteen (16) characters per line.
